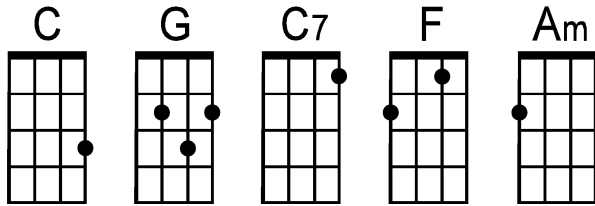


On the Wings of a Nightingale (Key of C)
