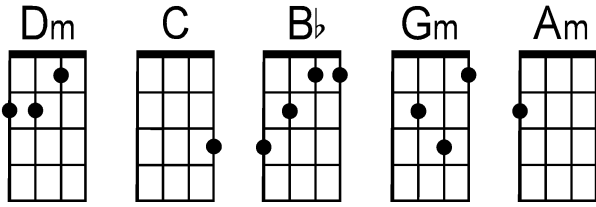


# Snow (in D minor)
