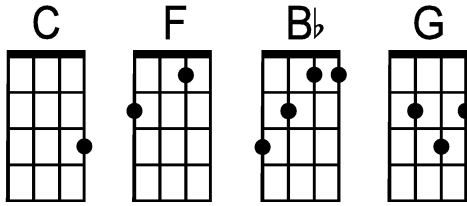


Silver Threads and Golden Needles (Key of C)
