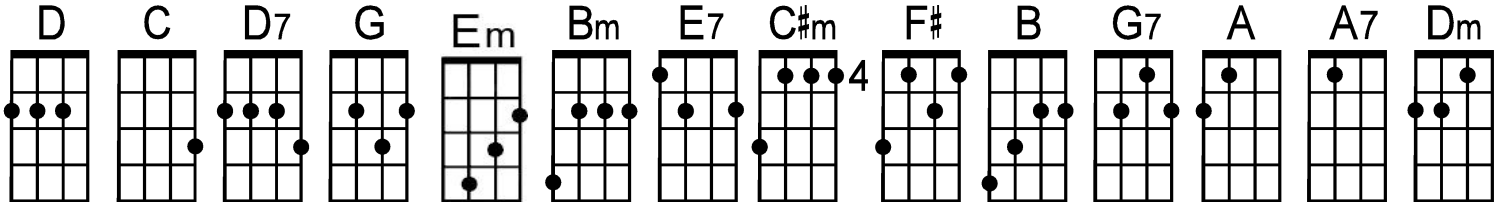


Where the Boys Are (Key of G)
