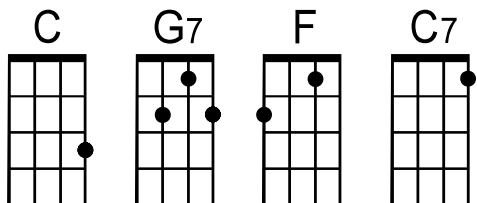


You Are My Sunshine
